



## 4. International Classical Guitar Composers Competition for classical guitar Rust 2021

**A.) Start of the composer's competition:**

1. September 2020 (00:00 MEZ)

**B.) Deadline for submission:**

30. June 2021 (23:59 CET)

**C.) Announcement:**

Top 10: to be released 1<sup>st</sup> August 2021

Winner: will be published 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021

Performance: will be released at International Guitarfestival Rust 2021

**D.) Topic:**

Composition of concert piece for classical guitar duo (6 strings) with a length of 5 (five) minutes. Tolerances of the performance duration of +/- 1 (one) minute are permitted. The composer should create a unique, contemporary work that exceeds the boundaries of the usual genre.

## E.) Competition:

1. Composition for guitar duo as described in *Topic*.
2. The compositions must be unpublished and not been performed in public yet. In addition, they must not have won any other competition. For the duration of our competition, the composition is not permitted to be published or submitted to another competition. Members of the jury of the composition competition 2020 are also excluded from participation.
3. The competition is open to composers of all ages and nationalities.
4. The pieces must be composed for a 6-string classical guitar duo. Additive technologies are not allowed.
5. Multiple submissions are allowed but must be sent in separate e-mails. The entry fee must be paid separately for each submission.
6. The compositions must be sent separately by e-mail to the address [composerscompetition.rust@gmail.com](mailto:composerscompetition.rust@gmail.com).  
Format PDF. An audio recording must also be added to each submission. This can be done either by human musicians or by a composition program. Recording format: MP3. The pages of the composition must be numbered sequentially, and the title of the work must appear on each page.  
The names of the participants may not appear on any side of the work or the MP3 file.
7. The fee for participation in the competition is € 75 (sixty-six EURO) for each composition submitted. Registration for the competition will be sent via e-mail to the address [composerscompetition.rust@gmail.com](mailto:composerscompetition.rust@gmail.com).

Any transfer costs shall be paid by the participant in the competition.
8. The registration fee will not be refunded, except for the reasons set out in point 9.
9. The competition starts on 1<sup>th</sup> August 2020. The closing date for submissions is 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021 (23:59). If there are fewer than 10 entries, the competition will be cancelled. In this case, the registration fee will be refunded.
10. The International Guitar Festival Rust reserves the right not to award a first prize.

The winner of the competition will be announced at 30. September 2020. The publications are made on the homepage of the Composers Competition and on Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn. The winners will also be informed via e-mail.

12. The jury's decision is final, and no correspondence will be made about the results.

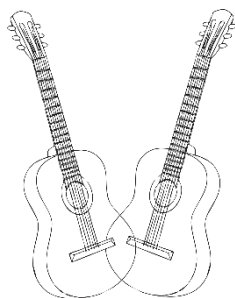
